

MISSOURI ACTE RECOGNITION AWARD

The Missouri ACTE recognition award is an award given to those outside the field of education in recognition of the highest meritorious contribution to the improvement, promotion, development and progress of career, technical and/or practical arts education. The recognition award is presented only to individuals and organizations whose contributions are of statewide significance.

A recognition award may be given to a member of the Missouri legislature who has rendered outstanding service in securing adequate support for career and technical education legislation. He or she may also be an editor or writer who has helped to inform the citizenry of his or her state and the nation about accomplishments, needs, and problems in the career and technical education field. The individual may be a farm leader, businessman, labor leader, leader for improvement of home and family living, or any other person who has otherwise rendered outstanding service for career, technical, and/or practical arts education. An organization could qualify for the citation provided it has taken an active role in promoting, improving, and expanding the role of career technical, and practical arts education.

Only under unusual circumstances will more than four recognitions be presented in any one year.

Three letters of support are required for this award, one of which must be from the nominator.
